

Anastasios Xepapadeas is currently Professor of Economics at the Department of Economics of the University of Bologna and Professor Emeritus at the Department of International and European Economic Studies of Athens University of Economics and Business. He is an elected international member of the US National Academy of Sciences, past president of the European Association of Environmental and Resource Economics and past Chair of the Board of Directors of the Beijer Institute of the Royal Swedish Academy of Sciences.
